To support the campaign, CPWR - The Center for Construction Research and Training has launched a website, www.stopconstructionfalls.com, as a clearinghouse of resources for the initiative. OSHA, NIOSH and the National Occupational Research Agenda (NORA) Construction Sector Council are pleased to announce the kickoff of our 2012 construction fall prevention campaign. Falls are the most fatal hazard in the construction industry, accounting for almost one in every three construction worker deaths in this country. The campaign will focus on falls from ladders, scaffolds and roofs, the three leading types of fatal falls. We are asking you to help us promote the fall prevention campaign by raising awareness among workers and employers about fall hazards and by providing information they can use to prevent injury and death.
